Graduation from a four-year college or university with a degree in chemistry, physics, mechanical engineering, chemical engineering, or a closely related curriculum and three years of progressive experience in industrial hygiene inspections (consultations); or an equivalent combination of education and experience. Masters degree strongly preferred; Industrial Hygiene Certification strongly preferred.

Applications must be received in this office by 5:00 pm on the application closing date listed on this announcement. Resumes may be attached to applications; however, resumes **will not** be accepted in lieu of a completed application (form ccpd 1). **Open recruitment positions may be closed at any time without notice.**

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT: (The selected applicant will be subject to the following conditions prior to or immediately after appointment. Failure to comply with or fulfill these conditions may result in dismissal.)

Selected applicant must submit to a drug-screening test and receive a negative result for the use of drugs specified in the county policy. Must have or obtain and maintain a valid North Carolina driver's license with acceptable driving record. Background check with local and national law enforcement agencies required.

GENERAL POSITION DESCRIPTION AND DUTIES: (Typical for this position – may be changed or amended without notice.)

The primary purpose of the Industrial Hygiene Consultant (IHC) position will be to function as an integral member of the PHRST Team with unique responsibility for anticipation, recognition, evaluation and control of environmental hazards to human health that are likely to arise in the event of a manmade or natural disaster. The IHC will assist the PHRST Team's assessment of cases of potential biological, chemical or radiological terrorism to determine the agent, source, and potential for transmission or dissemination and participate by conducting environmental and human exposure assessment. Additional duties would include risk assessment, risk communication, assessment of regional environmental preparedness, coordination of environmental data gathering and sharing with the state and within the region, coordination of environmental decontamination efforts and training of local environmental health staff, hazmat teams, utility operators (including energy and water supply), manufacturers and others. The IHC will serve the regional team to provide the environmental investigation component of epidemiologic investigations.

KNOWLEDGE OF WORK PERFORMANCE INDICATORS:

A general understanding of introductory statistics. Working knowledge of organic and inorganic chemistry. Working knowledge of biochemistry. Basic understanding of physiology. Working knowledge of industrial toxicology. Considerable knowledge of industrial processes, potential health hazards, and control equipment and methods. Considerable knowledge of industrial hygiene sampling techniques. Ability to explain hazardous situations to industrial officials, and to apprise them of potential danger to employees.
