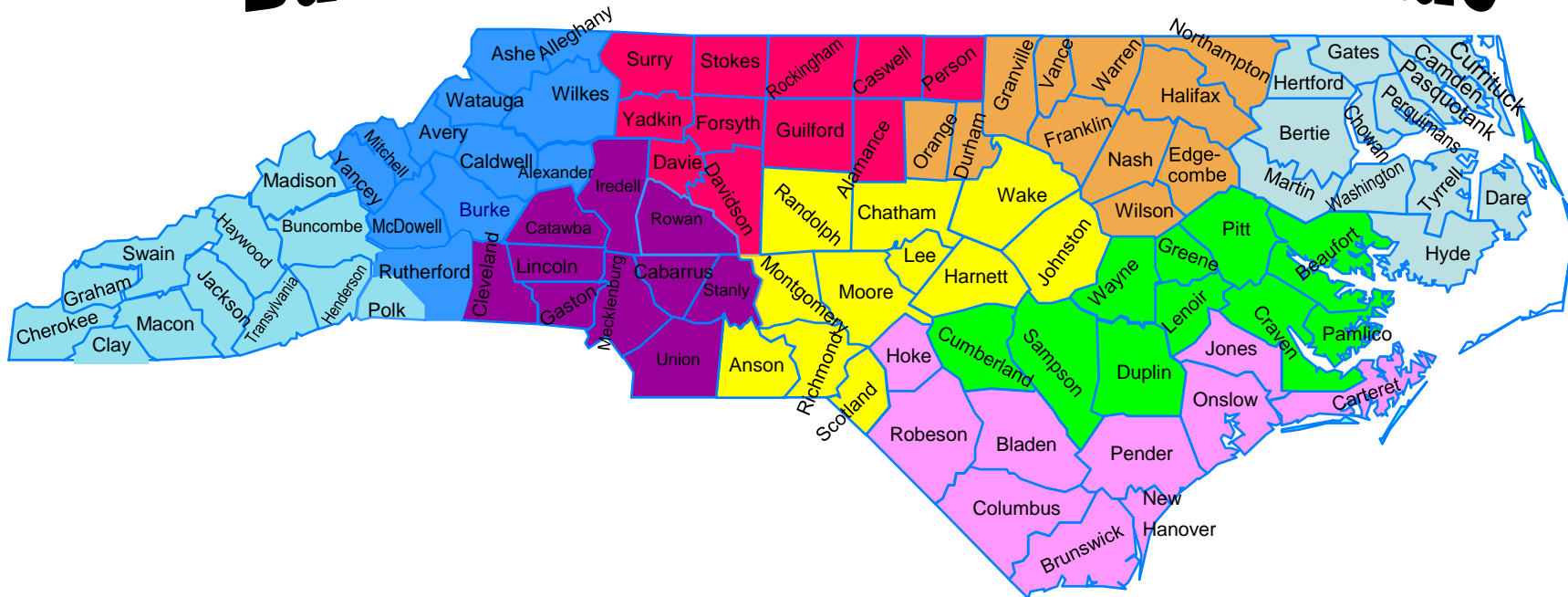

Core Membership of the 9 HLS DPR Committees (10 Disciplines)

- Public Health
- Municipal Police
- Sheriff's Department
- Hospitals
- Emergency Management
- Rescue
- Public Works
- Emergency Medical Services
- Municipal Fire Department
- Rural Fire Department



Core Membership of the 9 HLS DPR Committees

- Each core discipline has a subcommittee with county and municipal representatives who elect a member to represent them on the DPR Committee (DPRC).
- Each DPR Committee elects an overall chairperson to lead the activities of the DPR region; NCEM also furnishes an area coordinator to serve as a Non-Voting Executive Director.



BOTTOM LINE - WHY ARE THE DPRs **SO IMPORTANT?**

- 1. Each DPR decides as a regional team what their hazard response needs are & subsequently draft project proposals to request HLS funding to address those needs on an annual basis.**
- 2. DPR activities will enhance the ability of counties to effectively plan, train and exercise to ensure readiness to respond to all hazards.**
