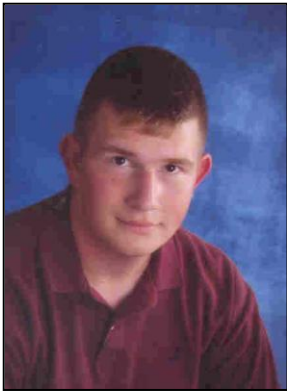


# Resource Conservation Workshop Scholarship

Each year Cumberland Soil and Water Conservation District awards the Resource Conservation Workshop (RCW) scholarship to a high school student from Cumberland County. This scholarship pays for registration, lodging, food and travel.

The RCW is a week-long study, including hands-on participation in a wide range of conservation topics, held on the campus of North Carolina State University. One of the main objectives of the RCW is to expose students to career opportunities in the management of natural resources.
