Cumberland County Board of Elections Absentee Meeting Nov 3, 2025

The Absentee Meeting was called to order by Chair Devore at 5:00 PM.

ACTION:

Member Grimes moved to approve the agenda. Seconded by Edmonds and approved

unanimously.

Shameerah Dixon presented for board consideration the following 85 absentee ballots: 54 civilian ballots received by mail, 11 civilian ballots with ID exception forms, 1 civilian overseas ballot received electronically with ID exception form, 6 military ballots received electronically, 1 military ballot by mail, 10 civilian overseas ballots received electronically, and 2 military ballots with ID exception forms.

The DS200 count was 41 prior to consideration of absentee ballots during this meeting.

Member Edmonds made the motion to accept the 1 civilian overseas ballot received electronically with ID exception form. The motion was seconded by Member Johnson and approved unanimously.

ACTION:

Member Eldridge made the motion to accept the 10 civilian overseas ballots received electronically. The motion was seconded by Member Edmonds and approved unanimously.

ACTION:

Member Edmonds made the motion to accept the 2 military ballots with ID exception forms. The motion was seconded by Member Johnson and approved unanimously.

Member Johnson made the motion to accept the 7 military ballots (6 electronic, 1 by mail). The motion was seconded by Member Grimes and approved unanimously.
