

Cumberland County Board of Elections

Canvass Meeting

Oct 14, 2025

The Canvass Meeting was called to order by Chair Devore at 11:00 AM.

Members in attendance: Devore, Grimes, Eldridge, Edmonds, Johnson

Others in attendance: Director of Elections Angie Amaro

ACTION: Member Grimes made the motion to approve the agenda. Seconded by Member Edmonds and approved unanimously.

Chair Devore started discussion of the challenge of the early voting ballot of Shaquille Miller due to an active probation period. The board members reviewed felony conviction and probation report presented by staff showing active probation.

ACTION: Member Grimes made the motion finding that Shaquille Miller is an active felon, and directing that his ballot be removed from the count. The motion was seconded by Member Johnson and approved unanimously.

ACTION: Member Grimes made a motion finding the challenge of the early voting ballot of Eleanor Clemons is sustained due to her provisional ballot being approved, and directing that her early ballot be removed from the count. The motion was seconded by Member Edmonds and approved unanimously.

ACTION: Member Grimes made a motion to sustain the challenge of the early voting ballot of Erica Clemons-Manuel is sustained due to her provisional ballot being approved, and directing that this ballot be removed from the count. The motion was seconded by Member Johnson and approved unanimously.

ACTION: Member Grimes made a motion to sustain the challenge of the early voting ballot of Larry Gibso due to his election day ballot being counted. The motion was seconded by Member Johnson and approved unanimously.

ACTION: Member Grimes made a motion to sustain the challenge of the early voting ballot of Roberta Gibson due to her election day ballot being counted. The motion was seconded by Member Edmonds and approved unanimously.

Next, Director Amaro presented the primary election results for canvass as the following:
14,253 total votes, 9050 election day votes, 75 absentee, 57 provisional, and 5070 early voting.

ACTION: Member Grimes made a motion to certify the primary election of the City of Fayetteville election recorded by the Director. The motion was seconded by Member Edmonds and approved unanimously.

Director Amaro stated that all of the voter challenges will be turned over to the state board for investigation.

ACTION: Member Johnson made the motion to adjourn the meeting at 11:26am. Seconded by Member Edmonds and approved unanimously.

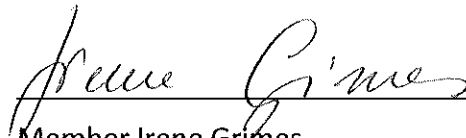
