## **Qualifications to become a Precinct Official**

#### You Must:

- Live in Cumberland County
- Be an active Cumberland County registered voter
- Be of good repute and able to read and write
- ✤ Be able to use a laptop computer

# You Must Not:

- Be an elected government official in any federal, state or local office
- Be a political party manager or treasurer for a candidate or political party
- Be a candidate for nomination or election
- Be related to a candidate running for office

## **Requirements**

- Must have reliable transportation to and from the polling place
- Chief Judges and Judges MUST work all day on Election day (5:30 a.m. to approximately 10 p.m.)
- Must assist with the setup of election supplies and voting equipment on the Monday evening before Election Day
- Must not promote or discuss any candidate, political party, policy or cause while working on Election Day
- Must attend all required training classes before each election
- Must work on Election Day in order to receive payment for attending training
- All Election Day workers are required to work from 5:30 a.m. until after the polls close and all necessary procedures have been performed (usually around 8:00 to 8:30)
