March 2017 Workforce Development Activities at the CC Public Library

HIGHLIGHTS



The library collaborated with the Department of Social Services (DSS) to provide an internet job café at the *March Into Work* job fair on March 21. The staff set up 35 computers to assist 117 job seekers with completing online applications and résumé help. Details of the *NCWorks* job portal and library services & information was shared with 381 job seekers at the café and the library information booth. Capability to print résumés was also provided for the first time by Copiers Plus, Inc. Library staff provided flash drives for job seekers to print their résumés free of charge at the Copiers Plus booth.

March's Book-a-Librarian sessions included staff assisting 62 customers with applications, résumés and cover letters to businesses such as Alliance Universal Security Company, Cape Fear Valley Health, Fayetteville Technical Community College, Goodyear Tires, Home Depot, Lowe's Home Improvement, Marlboro County, South Carolina School system, Methodist University, PWC, Sam's Wholesale Club, Sentel Corporation, Smithfield Foods and Walmart Vision Center. Staff also provided small business owners with ways to improve their businesses.
