ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY CHARLES EDWARD HOWARD SCOTT On His Retirement

WHEREAS, Charles Edward Howard Scott, retired on December 31, 2015 after twenty-five years of outstanding and meritorious service as an Assistant District Attorney in Cumberland County; and

WHEREAS, Charles Scott participated in and organized Civil Rights functions while a student at E. J. Hayes High in Williamston, N. C. and N. C. Central University in Durham, N. C. with the goal of peacefully protesting the conditions of the time; and

WHEREAS, Charles Scott was drafted into the U.S. Army in 1969, was commissioned through the Officer's Candidate School, completed the Special Forces Officer's course and was stationed at Ft. Bragg, N.C.; and

WHEREAS, Charles Scott attended law school at N. C. Central University during which time he would tutor young students in the community who were having trouble in school but did not have access to tutorial services or outside help; and

WHEREAS, Charles Scott rejoined the U.S. Army after law school, became a Judge Advocate; and was again stationed at Ft. Bragg, N.C.; and

WHEREAS, as a result of diligent work and demonstrated ability, Charles Scott served as the Assistant District Attorney for the 12th Prosecutorial District beginning in 1990 until his retirement; and

WHEREAS, Charles Scott assisted with programs designed for young offenders over a period of fifteen years, spoke individually and motivated young offenders who were overwhelmingly young black males and helped direct numerous young people to the Armed Forces as a way to better themselves; and

WHEREAS, Charles Scott prosecuted many large cases in Cumberland County during his twenty-five years as an Assistant District Attorney, was involved in thousands of felony cases and at least fifty homicides and mentored numerous young Assistant District Attorneys through the years with many attorneys in Fayetteville trying their first murder case as a second chair with "Uncle Charles"; and

WHEREAS, Charles Scott conducted "sit down" sessions with young men for over fifteen years and spoke to numerous school groups about being a responsible citizen.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, We, the Cumberland County Board of Commissioners, do hereby extend to Charles Edward Howard Scott our sincere and grateful appreciation for his outstanding record of personal and professional achievement and for his dedicated service to Cumberland County; our congratulations on his well-earned retirement; and our best wishes for continued success, happiness and good health in the years to come.

SUBJECT: LEGISLATIVE ISSUES IMPACTING ECONOMIC SERVICES PROGRAMS

BACKGROUND:

During the March 11, 2016 Legislative Delegation meeting, Social Services Director Brenda Jackson presented concerns impacting the administration of Economic Services Programs. Ms. Jackson shared several factors affecting the functionality and reliability of the North Carolina Families Accessing Services through Technology (NCFAST) system. Additionally she presented concerns regarding House Bill 318, which prohibits time limit waivers for food and nutrition benefits for Able-Bodied Adults Without Dependents (ABAWDs) required to meet work requirements in order to receive those benefits.

In response to the discussion, the Legislative Delegation requested that Cumberland County submit to them a list of the specific requests in addressing these concerns.

Please find attached the list of specific requests prepared by Ms. Jackson, along with a draft resolution for your consideration.

RECOMMENDATION/PROPOSED ACTION:

Ms. Jackson and the County Management Team recommend approval of the attached resolution for submission to the Legislative Delegation.

Requests Regarding Concerns Impacting DSS Economic Services Programs

1) Needs Regarding Improved Functionality and Accessibility of NCFAST system

- Eliminate system wide defects that causes churn of work, low performance and local frustration by counties. Counties are unable to do work if the systems (NCFAST and North Carolina Identity Management Services NCID) are down which results in paper applications that must be keyed after the system is restored. Also defects can cause previous completed work in NCFAST to "kick out" causing counties to have to re-enter the same work back in the system. This causes duplication and churn of work.
- Improve the complicated multi-layer problem-solving process through the state Help Desk ticket system that prohibits the delivery of services, because the system will not allow the county to process a citizen's application or recertification.
- Create a system that is available 24 hours, 7 days a week, 365 days a year. This flexibility will allow counties to develop non-traditional work hours to address workload demands and improve federal timelines and quality standards.
- Stabilize staff turnover and improve staff retention and recruitment, as well as continuity at the state IT level. Invest in a recruitment and retention plan to attract highly skilled IT professional in the competitive Research Triangle Park market.
- Improve state interagency collaboration, coordination and communication between NCFAST, Operational Support Team, North Carolina Identity Management (NCID) and policy development within NC DHHS to improve problem solving, and policy development that impact county productivity and performance.

2) Needs Regarding Legislation for ABAWDs:

• Allocate state funding to support HB318 to allow a robust Employment and Training Program to include services that can support mandatory work related activities to include expenses related transportation, training/certification/licensures, uniforms, etc.

RESOLUTION TO MAKE SPECIFIC REQUESTS OF OUR LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION REGARDING CONCERNS IMPACTING THE ADMINISTRATION OF CUMBERLAND COUNTY ECONOMIC SERVICES PROGRAMS

Whereas Cumberland County Department of Social Services continues to struggle with issues created by the functionality and accessibility of the North Carolina Families Accessing Services through Technology (NCFAST) and North Carolina Identity Management Services (NCID) Systems with one of the most limiting aspects of these systems being that they are not available for use after 9:00 p.m. on workdays or at all on weekends.

Whereas these issues with the functionality and accessibility of the State's technology systems is a major cause of the Cumberland County Department of Social Services continuing to have difficulties meeting federal mandates regarding Food and Nutrition Services (FNS) timeliness and quality standards; and

Whereas deficiencies in meeting the federal standards by any one large county in the State will likely have a state-wide impact on the administration of these programs by all counties; and

Whereas the Cumberland County Department of Social Services is concerned about limited opportunities and resources available to Able-Bodied Adults Without Dependents (ABAWDs), who will be subject to time limits for food and nutrition benefits under proposed legislation in HB318.

Therefore, be it resolved that the Cumberland County Board of Commissioners requests the support of the County's Legislative Delegation in passing legislation to alleviate the impacts of these issues as follows:

(1) By increasing the number of hours each work day and adding hours over each weekend that the State's NCFAST AND NCID technology systems are available for full use by counties to the end that counties will have the flexibility to add work shifts beyond the traditional 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. workday to meet federal time and quality standards;

(2) By enhancing the State's recruitment and retention of highly-skilled Information Technology (IT) staff in order to stabilize the turnover of personnel and improve the quality of assistance to users of the system to the end that these systems become more functional and have less downtime;

(3) By requiring NC DHHS to create workgroups which include representatives from county Departments of Social Services to develop collaboration, coordination and communication between NCFAST, Operational Support Team, NCID and NC DHHS to solve the problems and address the issues that impact county productivity and performance in the administration of these federal programs; and.

(4) By allocating sufficient State funding to implement the provisions in HB318 impacting ABAWDs, to the end that a robust Employment and Training Program can be developed that includes services that that are essential to employability such as expenses related transportation, training/certification/licensures, uniforms, etc.

BACKGROUND
