On Monday, December 8th at 10:00 Cumberland County Community Development and Kingdom Community Development Corporation plan to break ground for the Chapel Hill Road Project in Spring Lake.

Kingdom Community Development Corporation (KCDC) is a non-profit housing organization dedicated to building homes for low-to-moderate income families.

The Chapel Hill Road Project will consist of three homes. The total number of homes built by the KCDC, including these three, will be eighteen. Fifteen of those homes will have been built under the leadership of Carl Manning who became the Executive Director of KCDC in 2000.

KCDC has successfully expanded opportunities for homeownership by raising awareness within the community through Homebuyers Seminars. Many potential homeowners are not award they can purchase a home with or without special assistance. KCDC's broad-based outreach and marketing program, which includes education and training helps remove barriers and makes homeownership a reality for many low-income families.
