Scholarships Available for Children of Veterans

FAYETTEVILLE - The Cumberland County Veterans Services Office has two scholarship programs for children of Cumberland County veterans. A four-year scholarship program at North Carolina colleges assists qualifying children of certain class categories of deceased, disabled, combat, or POW/MIA veterans. The scholarships cover four years of tuition and fees. Some categories include room and board stipends. To qualify, the applicant must be under the age of 25 and living in North Carolina.

The second scholarship program is open to graduating seniors whose parent is a resident of North Carolina and an honorably discharged veteran. The scholarship pays \$500 directly to the student.
