Community Development Seeking Proposals For HUD-Funded Supportive Housing Programs

FAYETTEVILLE – Cumberland County Community Development (CCCD) is soliciting proposals for the administration of three housing programs funding through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The projects are all programs designed to help homeless people. The application deadline for proposals is Jan. 6, 2012. An informational meeting for applicants will be held Wednesday, Dec. 21, at 10 a.m. at the Headquarters Library.

Funds may only be used to assist persons meeting the HUD definition of homeless and chronically homeless. Funding will be provided directly from CCCD to the provider.

The three supportive housing programs are:

- Bonanza Permanent Housing Program – This program provides homeless individuals and families with HIV/AIDS or disabilities with long-term housing and supportive services. The grant amount is \$74,488.
- Step-Up Semi-Independent Living Program – This program provides homeless men with up to 12 months of housing and supportive services. The grant amount is \$34,897.
- Care Center Transitional Housing Program – This program provides homeless families who are victims of domestic violence with up to 12 months of housing and supportive services. The grant amount for this program totals \$145,113.

A meeting to answer questions about the RFP will be held Wednesday, Dec. 21, 2011 at 10 a.m. at the Headquarters Library located at 300 Maiden Lane. Applicants are strongly encouraged to attend.
