Diabetes Self-Management Classes Offered In Spanish

FAYETTEVILLE – The Cumberland County Department of Public Health is offering the Diabetes Self-Management Education Program (DSME) classes to Spanish-speaking diabetes patients. The program helps diabetic patients take control of their health by improving lifestyle habits and reducing the risk of complications caused by the disease.

The Spanish language DSME classes will be held Tuesdays from 5 to 7 p.m. every other month at the Health Department. The next classes start Oct. 22. An interpreter will be available for the assessment and class.

The DSME program begins with an initial assessment appointment with a registered nurse, followed by two group sessions covering diabetes education and nutrition. Follow-up visits will be scheduled at three months and one year after the sessions. The program offers helpful incentives; educational material on how to live well with diabetes; and examples of nutritious foods and ways to build your own healthy eating plan.

Patients must be referred by a primary care physician. The program is not administered on a walk-in basis. If you have been diagnosed with diabetes, pre-diabetes or gestational diabetes, have your doctor fill out the referral form and fax it to the Health Department at (910) 433-3695. You can call (910) 433-3615 to have referral forms faxed to your doctor's office. Forms are also available online by clicking under the "Health Services" tab on the Health Department website at www.co.cumberland.nc.us/health.aspx.

Medicare, Medicaid and Blue Cross Blue Shield health insurance will cover the DSME. Patients who have Medicare Advantage must be pre-approved. If you have another type of insurance or no insurance, call the Health Department at (910) 433-3615 or 433-3789.
